Self Ownership

I.D. Card

 - Tourist
- **A.** Stay 6 months less 1 day every year. or they can choose
- **B.** Stay 12 months less 1 day every 3 years.

- Immigrant (green card)
 Stay up to 10 years. (before citizenship applied)
- **4.** Children born in America of non-citizen Mother should NOT be automatically be allowed citizenship.

Gender

Inequality

- For every 2 men who graduate college, 3 women do.
- Women now out-earn men in the younger age bracket. (22-30)
- There are 10 men in jail for every women, despite not committing much more of the crime.
- If a 14 year old girl and a 14 year old boy have sex, the boy is the one listed as a sex offender.
- There are places in this country where 1/3 of the men are ineligible to vote because they are felons.
- Women get the child in any divorce situation by default, and can usually get most of the money and a paycheck too.
- If a woman doesn't want a child, she can abort it.
 If a man doesn't want a child, he has no say in the matter and the government will put him in jail if he doesn't submit to being used as an ATM for 18 years.
- Women won. It's time to help out the men, who are the ones at real disadvantage today.

- Exclusion can cause Envy and Alienation.
- A balance between Privacy and Community

Grouping

- People often discount their Individual Judgement to the Collectivist Judgement of the group.
- Groups Think can rationalize and cause members to lose sight of the truth.
- Group Rulers sometimes use secrecy or fear (such as fear of exclusion) to manipulate individual behaviour within the Group.
- Groups can bring out the best in people but also sacrifice their individuality and individual beliefs and standards allowing them to also submit to doing terrible things.
- People easily lose themselves in a spectacle.
- Most people are group creatures and need the perceived comfort of that social structure.

Group Rulers

- Leading a herd can be achieved by either PUSHING or PULLING
- The Herd members can fight/resist a PUSH far easier than a PULL.

Flocks

Shepherds (10%)

 Shepherds PULL the herd thru loyalty and respect.
 (sort of like Colonel Potter on the TV show "M.A.S.H.")

Some Because They Are Unique

- Some people are "Lone Wolves" because they have a unique ability or viewpoint.

Some Because They Have Contempt

- Such wolves might then band together with like-minded wolves, to multiply the power of their predatory effects.

Why Know?

Curiosity

Some seek answers out of a simple and pure sense of curiosity.
 They look at the world around them and ask WHY.

Fear

- Some seek knowledge because they have a fear of the unknown.
 Fear is the most dangerous reason for wanting knowledge because of what fear brings with it.
 - Anger (fight or flight)
 - Hate (violence leads to violence)
 - Suffering

example: A finger wagging church of Fear, Guilt and Accusation; supporting evil in the name of good. and putting Souls in danger.

Hopelessness / Despair

- Some seek knowledge in order to make sense out of what is otherwise perceived as a hopeless existence.
- Hopelessness, such as living forever on Welfare or living with a Physical or Mental disability or an Addiction, can lead to self-destruction and anti-social behavior
 - My life is useless, so I do whatever I want.
 - Because I hurt, I hurt others.
 - I have paid with blood and tears; now they pay me in blood and tears.

 and the greed and lust associated with some forms of power
 often blur the ability to now when to pull back
 and when to know that control is often about what you DON'T do.

Patriotism

- Socialist politicians often skip July 4th parades and flag displays because such things energize only those who love Liberty, and sparks such a love in the young, and help to boost the turnout of liberty loving adults on Election Day.
- Fourth of July celebrations in the United States shape the nation's political landscape by reinforcing belief in Liberty and increasing participation, in Primaries and Elections.
- If elections were held soon after, it would benefit Liberty.
- Fourth of July celebrations in counties population by more Liberty loving people socialize children into an appreciation of the power of Liberty.
- Socialists gain nothing from July 4th parades,
 There is no evidence of an increased likelihood of identifying as a Socialist indicating that Fourth of July shifts preferences toward Liberty rather than increasing Socialist Tyranny.
- The three key findings of those attending July 4th celebrations:
 - When done before the age of 18,

it increases the likelihood of a youth embracing Liberty.

- It raises the likelihood that parade watchers will vote for Liberty
- It boosts the likelihood a reveler will vote.
- It increases the chances they'll make a political contributions.
- What's more, the impact isn't fleeting.
 The impact on political preferences is permanent,
 with no evidence of the effects depreciating as individuals become older.
